## **Rehearsal Schedules**

- Schedules will be posted mid-February
- Each week, 2 practices per court (different days)
  - Most rehearsals are 30-40 min (short be on time!!)
- For skaters in multiple courts we do try our best to group your rehearsal times together
- Please attend ALL rehearsals only THREE weeks of rehearsals before production week!

## **Production Week**

- A DIFFERENT SCHEDULE: Production week rehearsals are full run-throughs of the show, including staging, props & lighting
- You must attend all 4 rehearsals (Monday-Thursday)
  - Details of rehearsal times will come in your information package
  - "First-half" skaters leave first
- ONLY volunteers registered for dress rehearsals and performances may watch
- A very exciting time, but a BIG week
  - We do our best to stay on schedule
  - Please be patient we're working 24/7, and the kids are super excited!

### **Tickets**

- Sales open ONLINE early in March watch your email
- Prices \$25-\$30
  - \$30 for reserved seating (lobby end and ice level sides)
  - \$25 general admission seating in the stands
  - Second-half tickets for skaters only in first half \$15
- Purchases are only online by credit card
- Wheelchair-accessible seating, and "lobby seating" available for those needing a warmer environment

ALL SALES FINAL. No refunds or switching dates/times/seats. However, you may transfer to another parent or a friend.






# Why two dress rehearsals?

# Why does my skater need "hard" guards? Safety!

Walking to/from dressing room (sometimes on the stairs). Sharp skates = on-ice control.



## When is picture day?

- Program photos first week of rehearsals (no chance for a re-shoot)
- In-costume photos dress rehearsal 2

Professional skating photographer On-ice "action" photos First half and second half group shots Everyone gets photos at no extra charge
